AVAIL Browsers 4.5.8 Release Notes (released 3/16/2022)

The following new features were delivered as part of the **Version 4.5.8** release of the AVAIL Browser applications including AVAIL Browser for Revit, AVAIL Browser for Rhino, AVAIL Browser for SketchUp, AVAIL Browser for AutoCAD & Civil 3D, and AVAIL Browser for 3dsMax.

This release is primarily focused on improvements to the AVAIL Browser for Revit including better handling and communication of broken content and general bug fixes.

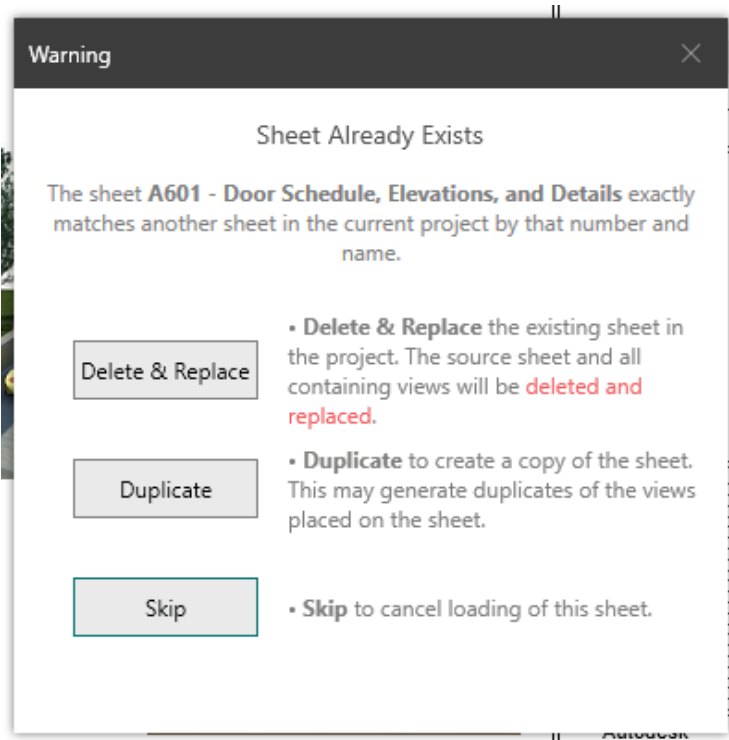

 - Added warning dialog whenever attempting to load a family type into the active project document when the family already exists
- Sheets

- Added warning dialog and logic for handling when a user is attempting to load an existing sheet. If the sheet being loaded matches by sheet number and name, the dialog displays and asks if they want to Delete & Replace the sheet in the active project, Duplicate the sheet, or Skip it. Replacing the sheet means AVAIL will completely delete the active sheet and any views placed on that sheet, and attempt to re-add them. Duplicate will create a copy of the sheet.



- Drafting Views
 - Added warning dialog whenever attempting to drag in a drafting view on a sheet that already exists will ask if the user wants to move the drafting view's viewport.

- Sheets
 - Fixed issue with the family type of the viewport's label on a sheet not copied over and set properly.
 - (REVIT 2022 API fix) Added support for matching the length and position of a viewport's label on an imported sheet.

- Fixed possible crash with adding Display This tags
- General
 - Fixed issue with Revit documents potentially getting out of sync with what the AVAIL Browser is referencing, causing the UI to be unresponsive to drag actions.
